Cory McFadden made a 91 point ride on bucking bull, Whamo, at the July 4th, 7:30 performance of the World's Oldest Rodeo.

Sleep America Night at the World's Oldest Rodeo started, when the Phoenix Jaycees Comancheros Pony Express delivered the mail they hand carried from Phoenix, to the Prescott Frontier Days® Rodeo Arena. Both performances provided outstanding stock and well qualified contestants. Great rides, fast times, and patriotic Americans were easily found.

The high score in the Bareback Riding is now a three-way tie between Wrangler National Finalists: Justin McDaniel, Will Lowe, and Bobby Mote. Though no one made a qualified ride in the Bull Riding, at the afternoon performance, the high score of the rodeo was achieved at the evening performance. Cory McFadden from Coleman, Texas climbed aboard a bull named Whamo, and eight seconds later, he was awarded 91 points for his efforts.
