



Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. 2022 Rodeo Parade Rules & Regulations

1. **ENTRY DEADLINE:** Entry form, entry fees, parade script, photo/sketch and participant waiver must be received by the Parade or in the Prescott Frontier Days® office by **Friday, May 20 2022**. No entry forms will be accepted after this date.
2. All Entries will be subject to the approval of the Rodeo Parade Committee. Any entry that does not conform to these rules and regulations will be eliminated from consideration. All decisions of the Rodeo Parade Committee are final. Entry fees are non-refundable with the exception of entries that are not approved by the Rodeo Parade Committee.
3. The Rodeo Parade Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries in the parade.
4. Inclement weather could delay the parade start time. Cancellation is unlikely.
5. Your parade position and final details will be sent by email **the week of June 13th**.
6. If your entry is a group, please be certain that all members of the group know their position number and all the necessary details prior to parade day. Provide a contact name and cell number for your group for the day of the parade on the entry form.
7. Parade must be kept moving in a timely fashion, there cannot be delays or stops to perform during the parade.
8. Your entry will be limited to no more than 60 feet in length and 12 cars total, riding side by side on the parade route. If you require more space, you must purchase an extra entry space.
9. If you need to be placed near a 2nd group or entry, please let us know in advance so that we can do our best to accommodate you.
10. **NO THROWING ANYTHING TO THE CROWDS ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE.** You may have someone walk along and hand items to the parade spectators.
11. Advertising, identification of floats and themes should be in good taste.
12. All float entries must have fire extinguishers.
13. Participants standing on a float/vehicle must have something stable to hold on to for balance. Children must be seated at all times.
14. All children under the age of twelve (12) years must be accompanied by an adult.
15. Due to live overhead power lines, the maximum allowable height of entries is 13 feet 6 inches.
16. For the safety of everyone including animals that may be startled, the discharging of firearms is strictly forbidden.
17. The judge's stage is located at the intersection of Union and Cortez, across from the courthouse. Winners will be announced in the Sunday newspaper, and emails will be sent to all the parade entrants. Parade awards may be picked up at the Rodeo Office starting July 11th, 9:00am to 4:00pm.
18. The staging areas open at 7:00 am and will be staffed with volunteers to help with parade preparation and to answer questions. All parade participants should be in their assigned staging area by 8:00 am. The parade starts promptly at 9:00 am.
19. Consumption of alcoholic beverages or drugs prior to or during the parade will not be tolerated.
20. **Animal Entries:** Please review the following guidelines:
 - For safety reasons, Animals that are noise sensitive are not permitted in the Parade.
 - Children under the age of twelve (12) will not be allowed to ride a horse alone during the parade; they must be accompanied by an adult walking or riding alongside.
 - All children under the age of twelve (12) riding on a horse **MUST** wear a protective helmet. No exceptions.
 - Any entry pulled by a horse(s) must have an adult walking alongside or riding with the horse(s) to help control the horse(s) throughout the parade route. A safety rope/out-rigging must be attached to the team lead to aid in stopping the team should it be necessary.
 - For safety reasons, only one (1) rider per horse.
 - All equine entrants should be familiar with Arizona Revised Statutes ARS 12-553 concerning Limited liability of equine owners and owners of equine facilities.
 - Use Washington Street to park your trailers and do not block any driveways.
 - **PLEASE BE RESPONSIBLE** — Bring water for your animals. Clean up after your animals in staging area. Be considerate of private properties and do not allow your animals on sidewalks, businesses or personal property.

THE RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT MUST BE READ, SIGNED AND AGREED TO BY EACH PARADE ENTRY AND IS INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE. PRESCOTT FRONTIER DAYS®, INC. WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE IF THESE RULES ARE VIOLATED.
